DIRECTIONS TO CHERRY STREET PARK (CHRIST LUTHERAN-BIG BEND)

Take Hwy 16 east to I-94 East. Continue on I-94 East to Hwy 164 South in Waukesha. Hwy 164S will take you along Moorland Ave and then south on the East Side Bypass around the south end of Waukesha to east Ave (simply follow the signs for 164 south). Continue following 164 South (left turn onto East Ave) to Big Bend (shortly after passing under I-43). Continue straight to the stop "light" in Big Bend (Edgewood Ave). One block past Edgewood, turn east (left) onto Park Ave. Continue one block on Park Ave to the bend where it joins Cherry Street. The ball fields are on the east (right) side of Cherry (8730 Cherry Street Big Bend, WI 53103).

Running and Reading this summer

We are once again participating in the "I Run Marathon" summer reading and running program. All children, 8th grade & under, are invited to participate. Students will run 25.2 miles over the summer and read 26 books or read for 26 hours, which will improve both body and mind. They may run or walk the 25.2 miles in ¼, ½ or 1 mile increments, and read in ¼, ½, 1 hour or per-book increments. Students will get a Log Sheet to help keep track of running and reading. By finishing, students will not only be considered a marathoner for life, but will also receive an I RUN Kids Marathon T-shirt, Finisher's Medal, and Goody Bag. Then, all students are invited to join us at the end of August (TBD) to run the FINAL MILE of the marathon and cross the finish line a WINNER! There will be music, food, festivities, and giveaways at the Final Mile event, which will be at the Wisconsin Lutheran College's Raabe Stadium located at 1401 N. Swan Blvd, Wauwatosa, Wisconsin (run on a real NCAA class college track!). The cost is only \$15 per student (a portion of each entry will be donated to Children's Hospital of Wisconsin).
